



Questions for Preschool children (clues can be found in the book)

- What do Pinky and Peet eat?
- Where do they live? Why do they live there?
- How big are they? (Why are they so small)? Invite children to work out how big they are.
- What colours are they? (Hint: relate this to their environment – their colours help them to blend in with their environment). Invite children to draw their own lizards.
- Who would eat Pinky and Peet? (Hint: relate this to biological life cycles). Encourage children to look for lizards and their habitat in gardens.
- Why should we look after Pinky and Peet? (Hint: relate this to conservation).
